## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act providing for a distinctive registration plate for firefighters..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:-
- The registrar shall furnish to owners of private passenger motor vehicles who are active
- 4 members, members retired in good standing, or the immediate family member of a firefighter
- 5 killed in the line of duty, distinctive registration plates which shall display on their face a design
- 6 indicating their status as firefighters. No such plate shall be issued or renewed until proper
- 7 certification has been made to the registrar by the chief of the fire department in which the
- 8 applicant serves. There shall be a \$10 fee for said plate in addition to the established registration
- 9 fee for passenger motor vehicles which shall be transferred to the Massachusetts Firefighters
- 10 Academy Trust Fund pursuant to section 165A of chapter 6.
- SECTION 2. In a state of emergency, any active member of a fire department driving a
- vehicle bearing the distinctive registration plate shall be authorized and empowered to travel
- 13 upon the highways of the Commonwealth, notwithstanding any driving ban imposed by the
- 14 Commonwealth or any municipality, in accordance with their official duties.
