An Act naming a certain bridge in the city of Malden..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The bridge on Mountain Avenue in the city of Malden, shall be designated
- 2 and known as the Joseph E. Croken Memorial Bridge, in memory of Malden Court Clerk
- 3 Magistrate Joseph E. Croken, a lifelong Malden resident who served the City of Malden, the
- 4 Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the United States of America throughout his life.
- 5 SECTION 2. The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority shall erect suitable
- 6 markers bearing said designations in compliance with the standards of said agency. The
- 7 department of public works for the city of Malden shall be responsible for the maintenance of
- 8 said markers.
