An Act providing for a distinctive registration plate for paratroopers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by
2	section 6 of chapter 220 of the acts of 2004, is hereby further amended by adding the following
3	paragraph:-
Л	The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles

The registrar shall furnish without charge to owners of private passenger motor vehicles who are veterans as defined in clause forty-third of chapter 7 and who as paratroopers and upon evidence deemed satisfactory by the registrar, distinctive, registration plates bearing the words "PARATROOPER" for a private passenger motor vehicle owned and principally used by such paratrooper.
