An Act designating a certain bridge in the city of Boston The Honorable Francis X. Coppinger Bridge..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1: The bridge on Park Street, in the West Roxbury section of the city of Boston,
- 2 shall be designated and known as The Honorable Francis X. Coppinger Bridge in honor of
- 3 Francis X. Coppinger who served in the Massachusetts House of Representatives for the Tenth
- 4 Suffolk District. The Massachusetts Highway Department shall erect and maintain suitable
- 5 markers bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
