An Act relative to the issuance of a motor vehicle citation for firearms arrests..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 22 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition,
2	is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (j) the following new subsection:-
3	(k) The registrar shall suspend or revoke, without hearing, a certificate of registration or
4	any license or right to operate of a person who is convicted of a violation of any provision of
5	sections 121 through 131P, inclusive, of chapter 140 or any provision of chapter 269 or adjudged
6	a delinquent child by reason of having violated any provision of such chapters; provided,
7	however, that the period of suspension or revocation shall not exceed five years; provided
8	further, that any person so convicted who is under the age of eighteen years and is not licensed to
9	operate a motor vehicle shall, at the discretion of the presiding judge, not be so licensed for a
10	period no later than when such person reaches the age of twenty-one years.
