An Act relative to the parking of motor vehicles at meters by certain persons..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The first paragraph of section 22A of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the  
2 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the fourth sentence, the following  
3 sentence:—

4           No fee shall be exacted and no penalty shall be imposed for the parking of any vehicle  
5 owned and driven by a member of The Legion of Valor of the United States of America, Inc., a  
6 recipient of The Congressional Medal of Honor or a recipient of The Order of the Purple Heart  
7 or a recipient of The Silver or Bronze Star provided, however, such vehicles shall display the  
8 distinctive number plate authorized by section 2 of chapter 90.
