An Act to protect nursing home residents.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 111 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 72Z the following section:-
- 3 Section 72AA. The department, in consultation with the secretary of elder affairs,
- 4 shall promulgate further regulations to promote and protect the interests and well being of
- 5 residents in nursing homes, rest homes, and long-term care facilities, including but not limited to
- 6 timely notification to the resident and designated family member or legal representative of
- 7 relevant changes in resident care, posting of care and communication standards in a clear and
- 8 conspicuous manner, and process for distributing a copy of all applicable rules and regulations to
- 9 the resident, designated family member or legal representative including a written
- acknowledgment of receipt.
