## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to the reform of archaic laws..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 16A of Chapter 264 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
2	SECTION 2. Section 24 of Chapter 265 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
3	SECTION 3. Section 18 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
4	SECTION 4. Section 26 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
5	SECTION 5. Section 34 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby
6	amended by striking out, in lines 1 to 2, the words "commits the abominable and detestable
7	crime against nature, either with mankind or" and inserting in place thereof the words:
8	engages in sexual relations.

SECTION 6. Section 35 of Chapter 272 of the General Laws, is hereby repealed.
