Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out subparagraph D of paragraph (1) of
3	subsection (d).
4	SECTION 2. Chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
5	Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section 87 the following section:
6	Section 88. The Department of Revenue shall not assess an individual who is an
7	employee or owner-employee within the meaning of section four hundred and one (c) of the
8	Code and who excluded or deducted elective contributions to plans defined in section four
9	hundred one (k) within the limitations set out in section four hundred and two (g)(1) of the Code
10	for tax years prior to 2009.
