An Act relative to lerner's permits..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	In Section 8B of Chapter 90 of the General Laws, and not withstanding and any other law
2	to the contrary the following is hereby amended by inserting in line 12 after the word "driver"
3	the following provision.

4 Provided further that the holder of the Learner's Permit is required at all times to display

5 two red L-plates positioned vertically, one such plate displayed clearly in the front passenger

6 window and the second plate displayed in the rear driver's window of the vehicle being operated.
