An Act Relative to Staffing of Ambulances..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary the
2	commissioner of the department of public health is hereby directed to establish regulations
3	regarding the staffing of ambulances based on the following considerations:
4	Emergency services responding to calls in municipalities of 10,000 residents or less can
5	staff an ambulance with 1 first responder acting as driver who is trained in CPR and basic first
6	aid and 1 emergency services technician of a certification level that is appropriate for the needs
7	of the patient.
8	The aforementioned change in regulations shall only apply when the staffing levels
9	regulated in section 170.305 in the Massachusetts Department of Public Health CMR 105

10 cannot be met in sufficient time to answer the emergency call.
