An Act relating to food establishment inspections..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 31E the
2	following section:-

3	Section 34F. Local health regulations shall provide that at the conclusion of each
4	inspection of a food establishment, the local health agent shall post a copy of each page of the
5	food establishment inspection report in a prominent location at or near the main entrance to the
6	establishment. Said report may only be removed by the local health agent at the time of
7	subsequent inspections. Failure to display the food establishment inspection report as herein
8	provided, or unauthorized removal of said report, shall result in a fine of \$500 for the first
9	offense and a fine of \$1,000 and a suspension of the common victuallers license for a period of 2
10	days for second and subsequent offenses.
