An Act providing for a certain exemption from the motor vehicle excise..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The excise imposed by Section 1 of Chapter 60A of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, shall not apply to a motor vehicle owned and registered  
3 by a member of the armed forces while such member is on active service.

4           SECTION 2. The words “armed forces”, as used in this act, shall mean the following: —

5           United States Army, Army of the United States, United States Navy, United States Naval  
6 Reserve, United States Coast Guard, United States Coast Guard Reserve, Army Nurse Corps,  
7 Navy Nurse Corps, United States Air Force, and United States Air Force Reserve, including  
8 women’s branches of said armed forces.
