## In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act requiring judicial approval of foreclosures of residential mortgages in the city of Worcester ..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the
- 2 contrary, all foreclosures of residential mortgage on 1-4 family owner-occupied property located
- 3 in the city of Worcester can only be initiated by the filing of a foreclosure complain in the
- 4 Superior or Housing Court for Worcester County. A residential mortgagor may raise any and all
- 5 available defenses to the foreclosure and to the contract for the underlying mortgage loan, in law
- 6 and in equity. The court shall have the authority to modify the mortgage or grant any other
- 7 appropriate relief. Mortgagors shall have a right of redemption for six months after the entry of
- 8 judgment.
- 9 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage and shall cease to have effect on
- 10 December 31, 2013.
