An Act providing an early retirement incentive for certain employees of the department of transitional assistance..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General  
2 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the state board of retirement shall  
3 establish and implement a retirement incentive for Bargaining Unit 8 employees in the  
4 Department of Transitional Assistance. Each employee eligible shall request and receive a  
5 combination of years of creditable service and years of age, the sum of which shall not be greater  
6 than five years of creditable service and years of age, provided said employee shall retire within  
7 sixty months of the date of enactment of this section.
