An Act relative to the selling of soft air guns to minors..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	Chapter 269 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 12A the
2	following section:-

Section 12A1/2. Whoever sells to a minor under the age of 18 or whoever, not being the
parent, guardian or adult teacher or instructor, furnishes to a minor under the age of 18 a soft air
gun, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 or by imprisonment for
not more than 6 months.

For the purpose of this section, an air soft gun is defined as a type of gun used for
recreational purposes, and firing non lethal projectiles. An air soft gun can be spring, gas or
electric powered.
