An Act relative to promoting tourism by lowering certain taxed..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 23A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after  
2 section 14 the

3 Section 14A. In order to promote tourism, the governor may lower the meal taxes to not  
4 less that 2 per cent and the gas tax to 5 cents per gallon. Said reductions shall be simultaneous  
5 and shall not exceed 3 days.
