An Act relative to jaywalking..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 89 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 12. In any city or town which votes to accept the provisions of this section, no
- 3 pedestrian shall cross a roadway intersection diagonally unless authorized by official traffic-
- 4 control devices; and, when authorized to cross diagonally, pedestrians shall cross only in
- 5 accordance with the official traffic-control devices pertaining to such crossing movements.
- 6 Pedestrians shall not walk against a signal light and cross at any place except in a marked
- 7 crosswalk between adjacent intersections at which traffic control signals are in operation.
- 8 Any person who violates the provisions of this section shall be fined \$25 for a first
- 9 offense and up to \$100 for a second or subsequent offense.
