An Act relative to dual truck automobile registration..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official Edition, is
2 hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:—

3 The registrar shall issue dual registrations for trucks, which may be used on automobiles
4 owned by the truck owner. The registration plates may be transferred from vehicle to vehicle.
5 Registration fees shall be 1 ½ times of that of the truck. Insurance shall be based on the higher
6 price which or the high risk vehicle whichever is greatest. Both vehicles shall be on the
7 registration. Registration plates shall be a symbol indicating dual registration. There may be
8 only 1 dual registration per household in the name of the truck owner only. Only drivers listed
9 on registration may drive the vehicles. Other vehicle may not be a truck; it must be an
10 automobile at least 50 per cent more efficient than the truck.
