An Act exempting Richard Corcoran and Kazimierz R. Piorkowski, Jr. from the maximum age requirement for appointment as a firefighter in the town of Westwood ..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 58, 61A and 61B of chapter 31 of the General
2	Laws, or any other general or special law to the contrary, Richard Corcoran of the town of
3	Mendon and Kazimierz R. Piorkowski, Jr. of the town of Millis may have their names certified
4	for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of Westwood, notwithstanding
5	having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service examination in connection with such
6	appointment. In all other respects, Richard Corcoran and Kazimierz R. Piorkowski, Jr. shall be
7	eligible for appointment to the position of firefighter in the town of Westwood only insofar as
8	they qualify and are selected for employment under chapter 31, any regulations of the civil
9	service commission and any lawful hiring practices of the town of Westwood.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
