An Act relative to the membership of the conservation commission of the Town of Stockbridge..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Notwithstanding section 8C of chapter 40 of the General Laws, the board of selectmen of  
2 the town of Stockbridge may appoint 2 alternate members of the conservation commission of the  
3 town for staggered terms not to exceed 3 years.

4           The chairman of the conservation commission may designate any of the alternate  
5 members to sit on the commission in the case of absence, inability to act or conflict of interest on  
6 the part of a member of the commission or, in the event of a vacancy on the conservation  
7 commission, until the vacancy is filled in accordance with said section 8C of said chapter 40.
