An Act Relative to Temporary Handicapped Placards..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The ninth paragraph section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
- 2 2006 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the eight sentence the following 7
- 3 sentences:-A placard shall be issued for a 90 day period to applicants who have a disability that
- 4 is temporary in nature and may be renewed for a like period based upon continued disability.
- 5 Any person needing more than 1 renewal shall be referred to the registrar. The temporary
- 6 placard shall be the same size and design as a regular placard but shall be red in color.
- 7 "Temporary disability" means a disability that lasts for 6 months. Such placard shall be
- 8 prominently displayed by hanging it from the rear view mirror so as to be visible through the
- 9 front window. If no rear view mirror is available, the placard may be placed on a sun visor or the
- dashboard so as to be visible through the front windshield.
