## In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Mary Markley, an employee of the trial court..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial
- 2 court shall establish a sick leave bank for Mary Markley, an employee of the Worcester district
- 3 trial court. Any employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of sick,
- 4 personal or vacation days to said sick leave bank for use by Mary Markley. Whenever said Mary
- 5 Markley terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank,
- 6 any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.
- 7 Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that
- 8 necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court.
- 9 This act shall become effective October 1, 2009.
