## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to filling a temporary vacancy in the United States Senate..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 140 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as appearing in 2008
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after subsection (e) the following new
3	subsection:-

4	(f) Upon failure to choose a senator in congress or upon a vacancy in said office the
5	governor shall make a temporary appointment to fill the vacancy; provided, however, that the
6	person so appointed shall serve until the election and qualification of the person duly elected to
7	fill such vacancy pursuant to paragraph (a) or paragraph (c); and provided further, any person so
8	appointed shall be of the same political party as the person vacating the office and thereby
9	creating the vacancy.
