Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

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(b) A licensee under section 71 that holds itself out to the public or advertises that it is a
provider of specialized services and programming for dementia special care units in long term
care facilities must meet the standards set forth under this section in order to provide said
services. Nursing homes that operate SCUs must disclose to consumers and the Massachusetts
Department of Public Health what specialized services the SCU provides for patients affected by
Alzheimer's and related dementias.

Section 710. A licensee of the Department of Public Health under section 71 shall be
required to provide dementia specific training for all direct care workers, activities directors and
supervisors of direct care workers in both traditional nursing homes and dementia special care
units (SCUs).

SECTION 2. The department of public health shall adopt its Initial regulations to
implement this act not later than January 1, 2010.
