An Act Relating to MCAS Tutoring..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Any high School student with at least a 3.0 average in the student’s senior year shall,  
2 with the consent of the school’s principal and a recommendation of a teacher, be allowed to  
3 commit three hours a week to tutoring student in preparation for the MCAS tests, and upon  
4 completion of tutoring service for one year, be entitled to a tuition credit of \$500.00, if the  
5 student matriculates to a public state college or university.

6           The funds for tuition credit shall come from appropriations for MCAS tutors and shall  
7 be contingent upon their availability.
