An Act Naming A Certain Bridge In The Town Of Dalton..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The bridge No. D-1007 on Route 8 in the town of Dalton shall be
2	designated and known as the 2nd Lt. Michael J. Casey, Sr. Memorial Bridge, in the memory of
3	2nd Lt. Michael J. Casey, Sr., U.S.M.C., who was killed in action in Vietnam.
4	SECTION 2. The department of highways shall erect suitable markers bearing said
5	designation in compliance with the standards of said department. The department of public
6	works for the town of Dalton shall be responsible for the maintenance of said markers.
