An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank For Olivia Mulhall, an Employee of The Department of the Trial Court..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to  
2 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of the trial court,  
3 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation  
4 of the public convenience.

5           Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,  
6 and by the authority of the same, as follows:

7           Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
8 department of the trial court shall establish a sick leave bank for Olivia Mulhall, an employee of  
9 the Norfolk division of the probate and family court department of the trial court. Any employee  
10 of the department of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more of his sick, personal or  
11 vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by said Olivia Mulhall. Upon such time as Olivia  
12 Mulhall terminates employment with the department of the trial court or requests to dissolve the  
13 sick leave bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court

14 paid leave bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or  
15 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the  
16 department.
