## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

An Act MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 TO PROVIDE FOR SUPPLEMENTING CERTAIN EXISTING APPROPRIATIONS AND FOR CERTAIN OTHER ACTIVITIES AND PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	To provide for certain collective bargaining costs, including the cost of salary
2	adjustments and other economic benefits authorized by a collective bargaining agreements
3	between Barnstable county sheriff's department and the International Brotherhood of
4	Correctional Officers, Criminal Investigators, and Berkshire county sheriff's department and the

6	Communications Workers of America, and Dukes county sheriff's department and the
7	Massachusetts Correction Officers Federated Union, Essex county sheriff's department and the
8	International Brotherhood of Correctional Officers, Local RI-71, and Essex count sheriff's
9	department and the International Brotherhood of Correctional Officers, Local RI-27, and Suffolk
10	county sheriff's department and the Jail Officers and Employees Association of Suffolk County,
11	and Worcester county sheriff's department and the New England Police Benevolent
12	Association/AFL-CIO, Local 275, and University of Massachusetts - Amherst and the Graduate
13	Employees Organization – United Auto Workers, Local 2322, and the Board of Higher

- Local 106, and the Board of Higher Education and the Massachusetts Teachers'
