An Act addressing LGBT elder inclusion..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 19A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 official edition, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following new section:
- 3 Section 6A: The department shall focus on the prevention and elimination of
- 4 discrimination based on sexual orientation and gender identity and expression, as well as on
- 5 improving access to services for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender elders and caregivers. To
- 6 that end, the department shall work to ensure that a curriculum is developed that will support the
- 7 training for the delivery of services. The department shall require that over a period of time such
- 8 training be completed by all providers of services who contract with or receive funding from the
- 9 department, from Aging Service Access Points and/or from the MassHealth Office of Long Term
- 10 Care, or whose services are certified by the department.
- The department shall develop a process and timeframe for completing such trainings by
- those who deliver services.
