AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR THOMAS TROY. ..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whereas, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to
2 establish forthwith a sick leave bank for a certain employee of the department of corrections,
3 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation
4 of the public convenience.

5 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
6 and by the authority of the same, as follows:

7 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the
8 contrary, the department of corrections shall establish a sick leave bank for Thomas Troy, an
9 employee of the department of corrections. Any employee of the department of corrections or the
10 trial court of the Commonwealth may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation
11 days to the sick leave bank for use by Thomas Troy. Whenever Thomas Troy terminates
12 employment with the department of corrections or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, any
13 remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the department of corrections paid
14 leave bank. Sick leave bank days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or

15 disability that necessitated the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the
16 department of corrections.
