# The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

#### In the Year Two Thousand Ten

An Act Making Appropriations for the Fiscal Year 2010 to Provide for Supplementing Certain Existing Appropriations and for Certain Other Activities and Projects.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation 2 act and other appropriation acts for fiscal year 2010, the sums set forth in section 2 are hereby 3 appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in this act or in 4 those appropriation acts, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this 5 act or in those appropriation acts, and subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public 6 funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. These sums shall be in addition to any amounts previously authorized and made available for the purposes of those items.

SECTION 6. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, any unexpended balances, not to exceed a total of \$15,000,000, in items 4000-0600 and 4000-0700 of section 2 of chapter 27 of the acts of 2009, shall not revert to the General Fund until September 1, 2010, and may be used by the executive office of health and human services to pay for services provided during fiscal year 2010.
