An Act Authorizing the Town of Sudbury to Enter into Long-Term Energy Related Leases / Contracts Including Power Purchase Agreements..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 40
- 2 §3, or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Town of Sudbury by its Town
- 3 Manager, with the approval of the Board of Selectmen, is authorized to enter into long-term
- 4 leases, contracts, including power purchase agreements, with companies providing energy
- 5 facilities on Town lands or buildings in excess of twenty years. Section 2. Said Act shall take
- 6 effect upon its passage and without further submission to a town meeting.
