An Act authorizing the Town of Danvers to grant an additional license for the sale of wine and malt beverages..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws or any other  
2 general or special law to the contrary, the licensing authority of the town of Danvers may grant  
3 an additional license for the sale of wine and malt beverages to be drunk on the premises to d/b/a  
4 McKinnon’s Butcher Shop in the town of Danvers under section 15 of said chapter 138. Said  
5 license shall be subject to all of said chapter 138 except said section 17.

6           Notwithstanding any General or special law, or any rule or regulation to the contrary,  
7 the local alcohol licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other  
8 location. Said license may be granted by the local alcohol licensing authority at the same location  
9 if an applicant for said license files with said authority a letter in writing from the department of  
10 Revenue indicating that said license is in good standing with said Department and that any and  
11 all applicable taxes have been paid.

12           If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, such  
13 license shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions

14 pertaining thereto to the local alcohol licensing authority. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter  
15 138 of the General Laws, or any other General or special law or rule or regulation to the  
16 contrary, the local alcohol licensing authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at the  
17 same location and under the same conditions as specified in this section. SECTION 2. This act  
18 shall take effect upon its passage.
