An Act to convey certain Commonwealth property consisting of the waters of Farm Pond, its tributaries, and water distribution system to the town of Sherborn..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the commissioner of capital asset  
2 management and maintenance, in consultation with the commissioner of mental health, , shall  
3 grant, convey and deed over without consideration to the town of Sherborn all rights, title or  
4 other real property interests that the commonwealth may hold pursuant to chapter 251 of the acts  
5 of 1897 and chapter 466 of the acts of 1908, to the waters of Farm pond in the town of Sherborn,  
6 the tributaries of such Farm Pond, and to a certain easement together with a pipeline from said  
7 pond running underground within the town of Sherborn, to the boundary between the town of  
8 Sherborn and the town of Medfield, heretofore used to convey such waters to the former  
9 Medfield State Hospital. The town of Sherborn may use such rights and interests for public  
10 recreation, water supply and fire protection purposes.
