An Act TO PROTECT GROUNDWATER LEVELS..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the secretary of 2 the executive office of energy and environmental affairs, in cooperation with other state and 3 federal agencies, shall prepare a map of present and formerly submerged lands and tidal flats, 4 including filled lands, lying below the mean high water mark. The department of environmental 5 protection and other applicable state agencies shall provide information to the secretary in the 6 preparation of the map. The map shall depict, where feasible, the boundaries of properties lying 7 within and abutting present and formerly submerged lands and tidal flats, including filled lands, 8 lying below the mean high water mark. The secretary shall file a report with the clerks of the 9 senate and house of representatives who shall forward the same to the joint committee on 10 environment, natural resources and agriculture on or before December 31, 2011.
