AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SIGNING OF WARRANTS FOR PAYMENT IN THE TOWN OF PEMBROKE..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections 52 or 56 of chapter 41 of the  
2   General Laws, or of any other general or special law to the contrary, the town administrator in  
3   the town of Pembroke is hereby authorized to approve all warrants for payment of town funds,  
4   including payroll warrants. The approval of all such warrants by the town administrator shall be  
5   sufficient authority to authorize payment of the same by the town treasurer, but the board of  
6   selectmen shall approve all such warrants in the event of the absence of said town administrator  
7   or a vacancy in the office of town administrator.
