An Act establishing a sick leave bank for Edward A. Driscoll, an employee of the Trial Court..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule or regulation to the  
2 contrary, the trial court of the commonwealth shall establish a sick leave bank for Edward A.  
3 Driscoll an employee of the Office of the Commissioner of Probation. Any employee of the trial  
4 court may contribute 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use by  
5 Edward A. Driscoll. Upon such time as said Edward A. Driscoll termination employment with  
6 said trial court or requests to dissolve said sick bank the balance of sick leave shall be transferred  
7 to the trial court paid leave bank.
