An Act authorizing the town of Belmont to licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises of certain restaurants.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Belmont may, at its discretion,  
2 grant licenses for the sale of all alcoholic beverages in restaurants having at least 60 and not  
3 more than 250 seats; provided, however, that not more than 10 such licenses shall be in effect,  
4 including those presently issued. The licenses shall be subject to all the other provisions of said  
5 chapter 138 of the General Laws.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
