An Act authorizing the town of Dedham to grant an additional license for the sale of all alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. (a) Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws, the
2 licensing authority of the town of Dedham may grant an additional license for the sale of all
3 alcoholic beverages to be drunk on the premises under section 12 of said chapter 138 to Centre
4 Market, Inc. at 545 High Street in said town. The license shall be subject to all of said chapter
5 138 except said section 17. (b) The local alcohol licensing authority shall not approve the
6 transfer of said license to any other location. Said license may be granted by the local alcohol
7 licensing authority at the same location if an applicant for said license files with said authority a
8 letter in writing from the department of Revenue indicating that said license is in good standing
9 with said Department and that any and all applicable taxes have been paid.

10 (c) If the license granted under this section is cancelled, revoked or no longer in use, such
11 license shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions
12 pertaining thereto to the local alcohol licensing authority. Notwithstanding section 17 of chapter

13 138 of the General Laws, the local alcohol licensing authority may then grant the license to a
14 new applicant at the same location and under the same conditions as specified in this section.

15 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
