An Act Establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Patrick Ceurvels, an Employee of the Trail Court...

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial
- 2 court shall establish a sick leave bank for Patrick Ceurvels a court officer in the Boston
- 3 Municipal Court. An employee of the trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick,
- 4 personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for the use by Patrick Ceurvels. Whenever
- 5 Patrick Ceurvels terminates employment with the trial court or requests to dissolve the sick leave
- 6 bank, any remaining time in the sick leave bank shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave
- 7 bank. Sick leave bank days shall not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability
- 8 that necessitates the establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the trial court.
