An Act establishing a Sick Leave Bank for Maurice Jandreau, an employee of the Trial Court..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

| 1 | SECTION 1: Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation to the |

| 3 | Maurice Jandreau, an employee of the department. Any employee of the department may |
| 4 | voluntarily contribute one or more sick, personal or vacation days to the sick leave bank for use |
| 5 | by Maurice Jandreau. Whenever Maurice Jandreau terminates employment with the department |
| 6 | or requests to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the sick leave bank shall be transferred |
| 7 | to the Massachusetts Trial Court/Worcester Office extended sick leave bank. Sick leave bank |
| 8 | days may not be used for absences unrelated to the illness or disability that necessitated the |
| 9 | establishment of the sick leave bank as determined by the department. |
