## In the Year Two Thousand Ten

An Act changing the date of the annual town meeting in the town of North Reading..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The home rule charter of the town of North Reading, which is on file in the

office of the archivist of the commonwealth, as provided in section 12 of chapter 43B of the

General Laws, is hereby amended by striking out section 2-4-1 and inserting in place thereof the

following section:-

5 Section 2-4-1 The town meeting shall meet regularly on the first available Monday in

June not in conflict with a religious or legal holiday to consider and adopt an annual operating

and capital budget, and to act on other financial matters, as well as to consider and act upon such

other business as may properly come before the meeting; and on the first available Monday in

October not in conflict with a religious or legal holiday to consider and act on matters of

planning, zoning, subdivision control, building codes, and all other matters of a by-law nature, as

well as to consider and act upon such other business as may properly come before the meeting,

including financial matters; said dates for the June and October town meetings shall be set by the

board of selectmen at a public hearing held during a regularly scheduled meeting of the board

annually in January.

- SECTION 2. Section 2-5-1 of said charter is hereby amended by striking out the word
- 16 "April" and inserting in place thereof the following word:- June.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
