An Act Relative to Parental Consent for School Behavioral Screening..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, No child attending a public or

private school shall receive mental health or suicide screening without prior written consent of a

parent or legal guardian and shall indicate therein that such parent or guardian has read and

understood the parental notification statements concerning screening and follow-up prior to

actual screening.
