An Act authorizing the town of Bellingham to grant an additional restaurant all alcohol license..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding Section 17 of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, the  
2   licensing authority of the Town of Bellingham may grant one additional Restaurant All Alcohol  
3   License for Paul Winshman, 191 Mechanic Street, Unit #9, Bellingham, Massachusetts. Said  
4   license shall be subject to all of said Chapter 138 except Section 17.

5           Notwithstanding any General or special law or any rule or regulation to the contrary, the  
6   local alcohol licensing authority shall not approve the transfer of said license to any other  
7   location. Said license may be re-issued by the local alcohol licensing authority at the same  
8   location if any applicant for said license files with said authority a letter in writing from the  
9   Department of Revenue indication that said license is in good standing with said Department and  
10   that any and all applicable taxes have been paid.

11           If the license granted under this section is canceled, revoked or no longer in use, such  
12   license shall be returned physically, with all of the legal rights, privileges and restrictions  
13   pertaining thereto, to the local alcohol licensing authority. Notwithstanding Section 17 of the  
14   Chapter 138 of the General Laws, or any other General or Special law to the contrary, the local

15 alcohol licensing authority may then grant the license to a new applicant at the same location and  
16 under the same condition specified in the preceding paragraph.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
