An Act Authorizing the City of Gardner to Convey Certain Park Land..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Voted, to petition the General Court that legislation be adopted precisely as follows. The
2 General Court may make clerical or editorial changes of form only to the bill, unless the Mayor
3 and City Council approve amendments to the bill before enactment by the general Court. The
4 Mayor and City Council are hereby authorized to approve amendments which shall be within the
5 scope of the general public objectives of this petition.

6 AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GARDNER TO CONVEY CERTAIN PARK
7 LAND

8 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled,
9 and by the authority of the same, as follows:

10 SECTION 1. The City of Gardner, acting through its mayor and city council, may
11 convey a certain parcel of land acquired for use as a public common to the Greater Gardner
12 Community Development Corporation. Said parcel is more particularly described in ORDER
13 OF TAKING BY EMINENT DOMAIN A PARCEL OF LAND ON CHELSEA STREET dated

14 July 10, 1997 recorded in the Worcester county registry on Book 18985, Page 149 and shown on
15 Plan Book 740, Plan 73 also recorded in the Worcester county registry.

16 SECTION 2. The conveyance of said parcel of land shall be subject to the following
17 terms and conditions:

18 1. The premises shall be restricted to the development of not more than four (4)
19 dwelling units of which 100 per cent shall be subject to an affordable housing restriction
20 acceptable to the mayor.

21 2. Said dwelling units shall be sold or leased by the Greater Gardner Community
22 Development Corporation to individuals resident in Gardner, individuals with parents or siblings
23 resident in Gardner or individuals that work in Gardner.

24 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
