The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Nine

RESOLVE providing for an investigation and study by a special commission relative to the possession of marijuana in the commonwealth.

1 Resolved, That a special commission to consist of 3 members of the house of 2 representatives to be appointed by the speaker, and 3 members of the senate to be appointed by 3 the president, to make an investigation and study relative to possession of marijuana, which was 4 passed by the people as chapter 387 of the acts of 2008, and how this possession of marijuana 5 would affects public and private tenement housing, pursuant to sections 19 and 20 of chapter 139 6 of the General Laws. Said commission shall report the results of its investigation and study, and 7 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such 8 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on 9 or before the last Wednesday of January, 2010.
