## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

An Act relative to the central Plymouth County water district..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 371 of the acts of 1964 is hereby amended by adding
2	the following words:-, or in the opinion of the department of agricultural resources or the water
3	resources commission, the diversion of such waters would endanger the environmental health of
4	the associated ponds and rivers.
5	SECTION 2. Section 9 of said chapter of said acts is hereby amended by adding the
6	following paragraph:-
7	Furthermore, Silver Lake, Monponsett Pond and Furnace Pond shall be managed
8	at all times, unless prevented by drought, such that there is continuous flow provided to all the
9	out-flowing rivers, including Jones River, Stump Brook and Herring Brook, to support and
0	sustain their water quality as well as maintain the health and function of the ecosystem.
