4 SECTION 1. The pond, located at Gate 31 in the Quabbin Reservoir, also known as the
5 Robert D. Wetmore Fishing Area, in the town of New Salem shall be designated and known as
6 the Joseph P. O'Loughlin Pond, in memory of Joseph P. O'Loughlin, a former dedicated
7 employee of the department of conservation and recreation in the town of New Salem. The
8 department of conservation and recreation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing that
9 designation in compliance with the standards of said department.
