An Act relative to requiring insurance for Taxicabs and commercial vehicles ..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 34A of chapter 90 is hereby amended by adding the following to the definition of  
2 “Motor Vehicle Policy” liability.

3           Subject to and notwithstanding the foregoing, all Taxicabs and other Commercial  
4 Vehicles regularly used for the transport of individuals for a fee, shall maintain a policy of  
5 liability insurance to the amount or limit of at least one hundred thousand dollars on account of  
6 injury to or death of any one person, and, subject to the limits as respects injury to or death of  
7 one person; or at least three hundred thousand dollars on account of any one accident resulting in  
8 injury to or death of more than one person.
